What is an Article Activity?

- 1. Explaining One person from the group explains the entire article activity.
- **2.** Demonstrate tools for the activity.
- 3. Creatively grouping participants.
- 4. Reading the article or part of the article.
- 5. Discussing what has been read with small group.
- 6. Using a tool to demonstrate what you learned in the article.
- 7. Summarizing & Sharing. One person from the group summarizes the activity, leading the whole group in a discussion/wrap-up. Share what has been created with other participants.

- 5. Create a Wordle or Tagxedo with important information from the articles.
- 6. Wrap-Up: Dustin summarizes the activity, leads the whole in some sort of summary discussion. Share the products created.
