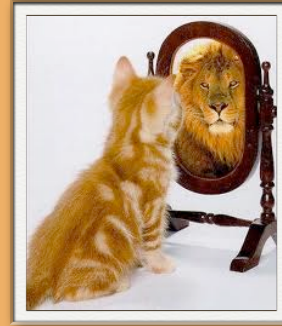

- d. Contribute to the effectiveness, vitality, and self-renewal of the teaching profession and of their school and community



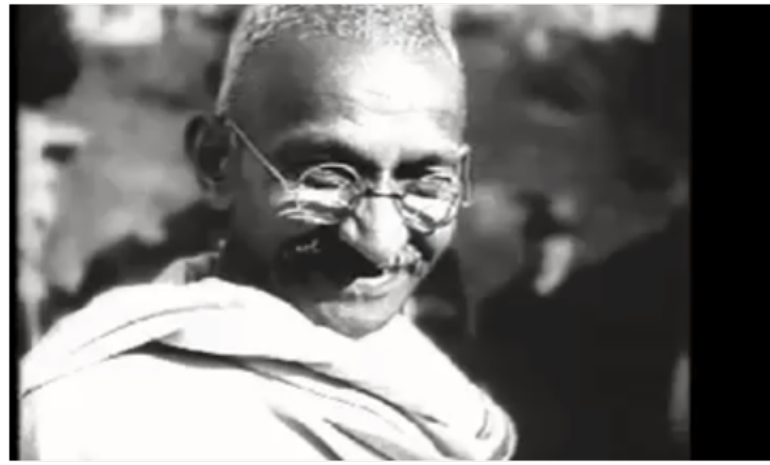
# NETS<sup>\*</sup>T

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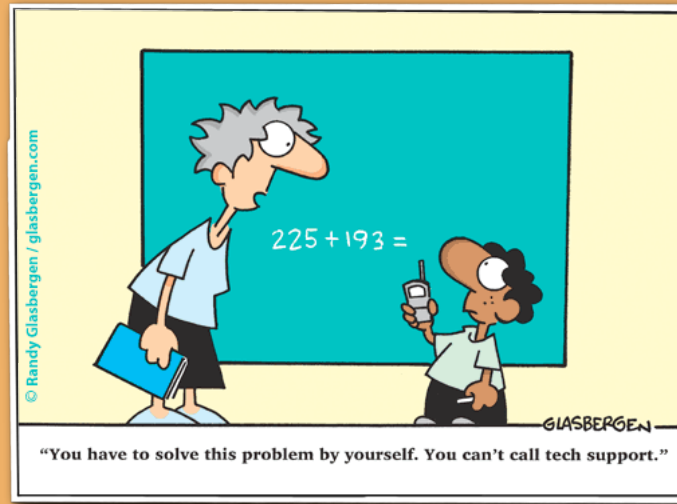
